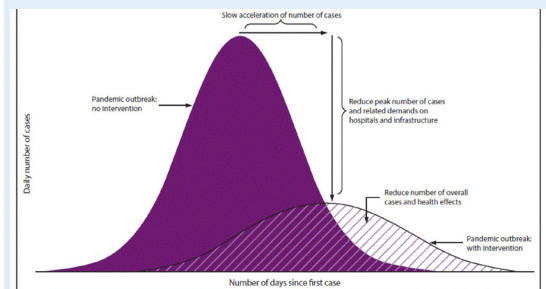
Bargaining

- **BC Hydro** – Tentative agreement reached; ratification vote deadline of April 8.
- **BCCNP** – All non-monetary items resolved; parties met again March 11 & 13 to conclude monetary items.
- **BC Transit** – Union tabled monetary proposals on March 11 & 13.
- **Beach Place Ventures** – Met with committee in efforts to customize bargaining survey and discuss current issues, including market share impact of ridesharing entities.
- **Berlitz** – Reviewed branch finances up to 2019 including employee earnings; begun discussions with employer on lump sum amount for lack of wage increases over last 4 years and accounted for wage increases over length of collective agreement; have met with employer to discuss potential extensions.
- **Broadway Driving School** – Anticipating bargaining to begin in early April.
- **Coast Mountain Bus** – Tentative agreement ratified March 24.
- **Coastal Community Credit Union** – Parties met March 19 & 20.
- **Coastal Community Insurance** – Waiting for CCCU to finalize bargaining.
- **CUPE 3338** – Bargaining continues; working on updated job descriptions.
- **FortisBC Energy Inc./ FortisBC Inc.** – Amalgamation vote rejected by membership.
- **ICBC** – Parties continue to meet; government announced transformative changes to ICBC to be introduced over the next year; we will need to amend our bargaining agenda to incorporate proposals to address this development.
- **Kelowna Cabs** – Waiting to resume bargaining following committee member resignation.
- **Unifor 1928** – Looking to set dates for early April.
