
Bargaining

- **Beach Place Ventures** – Bargaining survey to go out shortly.
- **Berlitz** – Ongoing discussions regarding a rollover agreement due to impact of the pandemic; the employer is running at a deficit but no layoffs or branch closures are pending.
- **BCGEU** – Working on bargaining preparations; bargaining committee nominations are open until November 27.
- **Canadian Northern Shield** – We've requested the two previous bargaining committee members be reappointed to the committee in advance of the collective agreement expiry on September 30, 2021.
- **CMAW Bargaining Council** – One-year extension expires December 31; we're currently preparing proposals for bargaining.
- **Coastal Community Credit Union** – Parties went to the table November 25 & 27 which was unsuccessful and we're now applying to the LRB for assistance of a mediator.
- **CUPE 3338** – Discussions continue on a rollover agreement with changes to job description and general wage increase.
- **CUPE 454** – Committee reviewed proposals in September; we've reached out to the employer to discuss the optics and bargaining protocol during the pandemic.
- **FortisBC Electric & Gas** – LRB has ruled in favour supporting a common employer; the amalgamated collective agreement will be in effect until June 30, 2023.
- **Hastings Entertainment** – Parties have reached a rollover agreement until December 31, 2021; the union has recently received notice of a pending sale.

Bargaining cont.

- **Hertz** – Bargaining is still on hold pending bankruptcy protection process.
- **IAM 140** – We are working on extending a rollover until December 31, 2021.
- **Kekinow** – We've reached out to the employer to discuss expectations and structure of bargaining.
- **Kelowna Cabs** – We have an active bad faith complaint in at the LRB; the employer recently threatened to permanently close the dispatch area; as such the union has revised its petition to be heard on an expedited basis.
- **Kruger** – Bargaining is on hold while committee member is in quarantine.
- **Lu'Ma Native Housing** – Bargaining is tentatively scheduled for the first week of December.
- **Marine Workers & Boilermakers** – Notice has been served and we are working on scheduling dates.
- **Master Trade Union** – Tentative agreement was reached October 30; ratification vote held November 30; 100% acceptance.
- **Seaspan** – Parties have met six times; employer is asking the union for its wage increase proposal.
- **Southern Rail** – Parties have had informal bargaining discussions.
- **Teamsters 155** – Parties are scheduled to meet December 7.
- **TransLink** – Tentative agreement reached; ratification vote to close December 9.
- **Tree Island** – Parties met October 21 to 23 and 27 to 29; talks broke off as two sides are too far apart.
- **United Fishermen** – Proposals have been approved; will be serving notice to the employer shortly.
- **Vancouver Police Credit Union** – Parties met November 20, 23 & 24; a number of proposals have been signed off; next dates scheduled for January 19, 20, 28 & 29.
- **Vancouver Taxi** – Bargaining on hold due to pandemic and impact of rideshare.
- **VantageOne Credit Union** – Employer filed for s. 78 final vote offer which was rejected 100% by the membership; members also voted a 100% strike vote.
- **Victoria Shipyards** – Poly-party unions met October 28 to discuss membership survey results.
- **WAVAW** – Poor response from membership survey; membership meeting was held November 4.
