This letter is to notify you that you may have been exposed to COVID-19 at:

Public Health is requesting you monitor your health for symptoms. Please do the following:

- Monitor your health for new or worsening symptoms of COVID-19:
  - Cough Headache
  - Fever Loss of appetite
  - Muscle aches Chills
  - Fatigue Runny nose or nasal congestion
  - Sore Throat Loss of sense of smell or taste
- Stay away from crowded public spaces and places where you cannot easily separate yourself from others.
- As required, wear a mask in all indoor public spaces, including workplace common areas.
- Continue to practice good hand washing, maintain physical distance and keep your social circles small.

If you become ill or already have symptoms:

- Isolate yourself as quickly as possible for 10 days from when you first felt sick.
- Get tested for COVID-19. See the 'where to get tested' links to the right, or contact 8-1-1.
- If you do seek medical attention, let your health care providers know by phone before you arrive that you may have been exposed to COVID-19. Wear a mask to the visit and take a copy of this letter with you.
