

Emergency Resolution - Anti-Hate

30th Constitutional Convention of the Canadian Labour Congress

THE CLC WILL:

- 1) Encourage and support affiliates to:
 - a. Condemn attacks against workers, families and communities that support and defend trans, drag and 2SLGBTQI+ events;
 - b. Create flying squads to provide meaningful support to workers, organizations and communities facing attacks; and

- 2) Call for an emergency task force to develop a guide outlining Health & Safety tools for affiliates to ensure the safety of workers where events occur.

BECAUSE:

- Workers in libraries, schools, and Pride events have been subject to weekly anti-2SLGBTQI+ hate, threats, and intimidation for hosting trans and drag Story Time events in February, March, April, May;
- 2SLGBTQI+ workers experience hate, threats, intimidation - this is a workplace health and safety issue;
- Affiliates cannot be bystanders, as 2SLGBTQI+ rights are human rights;
- Violent threats are escalating weekly across Canada - this week an Ontario public library was targeted with threats to workers, performers, families and their children.
