September 2023



Bargaining

- **BCGEU** – Bargaining committee has been appointed.
- **BC College of Nurses** – Bargaining committee has been appointed and the bargaining package has been approved.
- **BC Computerized Dispatch (Yellow Cab)** – Tentative agreement was ratified on June 1. The members are to receive 3% (retroactive pay), 5% and 3.25% in the three-year agreement.
- **BC Federation of Labour** – Tentative agreement was reached with the employer on August 2. The tentative agreement was ratified August 14.
- **Beach Place Ventures** – Bargaining committee has been appointed and is working to secure more bargaining dates in the coming month.
- **BCNU** – Additional bargaining dates have been set with the employer for September.
- **Boilermakers Local 191** – Bargaining committee has been appointed.
- **Capilano University** – Tentative agreement was ratified July 28.
- **Cascades Casino (Langley)** – Bargaining committee has been appointed.
- **Catalyst Paper** – Bargaining committee has been appointed and the union is seeking dates with the employer. Bargaining proposals have been exchanged.
- **CCCU** – Tentative agreement was ratified on June 30. The members are to receive 4.5%, 3.75% and 3% in the three-year agreement.
- **CCIS** – A tentative agreement has been reached with a ratification vote scheduled for late September.
- **CIATU** – Bargaining committee has been appointed, and the parties met on July 12 and August 9. The union is seeking dates with the employer for September 2023.
- **CMAW 1995** – Bargaining committee has been appointed and the bargaining package is in the final approval process.
- **CMAW Bargaining Council** – Bargaining committee has been formed and the bargaining package has been approved.
- **Coast Mountain Bus** – Collective agreement was ratified by the membership on August 8.

Bargaining cont.

- **CUPE Local 454** – Committee met on May 26 to discuss proposals. Proposals have been drafted and approved by senior leadership.
- **FortisBC-CSC** – Collective agreement was ratified by the membership on June 9.
- **FortisBC** – Notice to bargain was served from the company on July 11.
- **Greenpeace** – Bargaining committee met with the employer for bargaining on May 23 and 24. The parties met in-person on July 17.
- **Gulf & Fraser Financial Group** – A tentative agreement was ratified on August 31.
- **Hertz Victoria** – Notice to bargain was served to the employer on July 17. Bargaining is anticipated to begin in early September.
- **IAM 250** – Bargaining committee met with the employer for bargaining in July. Additional bargaining dates have been set with the employer for September.
- **IWA Forest Industry PP** – A tentative agreement has been reached and a ratification vote is upcoming.
- **Kelowna Cabs** – Bargaining committee had in-person bargaining meetings set for August 23-24. However, due to the Kelowna fires, the meetings have been postponed until later in September.
- **Marine Workers & Boilermakers** – Draft proposals are complete; setting up meeting with senior union representative to review.
- **New Democratic Party of BC** – Tentative agreement was reached with the employer on July 21 and ratified on July 27.
- **PrairieCoast Langley** – Collective agreement was ratified by the membership on June 23.
- **United Fishermen & Allied Worker's Union** – Draft proposals are complete, setting up meeting with senior representative to review.
- **Vancouver Taxi** – Bargaining committee met with the employer on July 11, 18 & 25. A tentative agreement was reached on July 25 and ratified on July 28.
- **Vancouver Shipyards** – Poly-party bargaining began in February; parties have upwards of 20 dates set with the employer between now and the end of November. Progress is being made and proposals are being signed off.
- **VantageOne Credit Union** – Parties have agreed to commence the negotiations starting January 16, 2024.
